ACCEPTING SELECTIONS

GBR NOMINATED EVENTS

Selections made by British Fencing for Nominated Internationals are made through email and the Sport80 platform.

Athletes are contacted via the email associated with their Sport80 profile ~24hrs before the selections are published on the GBR website. These emails contain an accept/decline link. When the accept link is used, the competition is added to the Trips tab on Sport80, and the event can be paid for and entered. The Academy cannot access these Trip events through the club Sport80 account. There is typically a 7-day period to accept the selection.

Fencers must also have the appropriate international license. For EFC U17 (Cadet) events and EFC U23 events, an EFC License is required. For U20 World Cups, U17/U20 World Championships, Senior Satellite World Cups, Senior World Cups and Senior Grand Prixes, an FIE license is required. Both of these can be applied for through the Sport80 platform.

GBR NON-NOMINATED EVENTS

For Non-nominated GBR Events, such as EFC U14 events and non-nominated EFC U17s/U23s/FIE U20s, the process is slightly different.

Athletes will be selected by the Academy and contacted by email, with selections published in the Squads Whatsapp/Website and the competitions added to the individual calendars.

The Academy then requests the selections from British Fencing, and Athletes will receive selection from British Fencing via the email associated with their Sport80 profile ~24hrs before the selections are published on the GBR website. These emails contain an accept/decline link. When the accept link is used, the competition is added to the Trips tab on Sport80, and the event can be paid for and entered. The Academy cannot access these Trip events through the club Sport80 account.

Non-Nominated events often have a requirement for referee provision that is passed onto the fencers. If you receive this notification, please contact Bryn immediately so he can organise the referee provision.

ACADEMY NOMINATED EVENTS

For Academy youth trips -Events such as Challenge Wratislavia or Riposta Cup, the process is the same as for domestic events. The invited athletes will be directly contacted by email, selections published in the Squads Whatsapp/Website, and the competitions added to the individual calendars.

Entry is made via the tickets on the Academy Website.
